VENUE: Brisbane Show Grounds, entry Gate 5 off O'Connell Terrace, Bowen Hills

DATES: 22nd & 23rd April 2023

SET UP TIMES: Friday 21st April 2023. 1pm to Midnight (please indicate approximate arrival time on entry form to enable smooth transition into the building, note this is not a guaranteed time until final advice sheet is given).

SHOW TIMES: Saturday 22nd April 9.00am - 5pm
Sunday 23rd April 9.00am - 4pm

BUMP OUT: Sunday 23rd April 4.30pm - 11.59pm

***** ALL DISPLAYS MUST BE REMOVED BY 11.59pm (or sooner) Sunday 23rd April 2023 ***NO EXCEPTIONS*****

ENTRY FEE:

Entry Fee is \$65. The completed entry form including the signed rule sheet, **TOTAL** entry fee, including extra fees(if applicable) made payable to **Queensland Hot Rod Association Ltd** and current photo of the vehicle are to be forwarded to the Show Manager, Queensland Hot Rod Association Ltd., PO Box 366, Springwood Qld 4127.or email to entrants@qldhotrodshow.org EFT Payment details on Official Entry Form.

JUDGING: *****A fee of \$20.00 inc. GST will be charged for each vehicle required to be judged*****

Bonnet, boot and doors must be unlocked. Anything which is not accessible to the judges will not be judged. If access is unorthodox, please advise the Stewards prior to judging.

PHOTOGRAPHS:

A current photograph/image of reasonable quality must accompany each entry. Please note that photos will not be returned, and the Show Promoters reserve the right to use the photos/images as they require.

*****Entries received without a photo/image supplied will not be accepted*****

REJECTION OF ENTRY:

The Queensland Hot Rod Association retains the right to reject any entry without assigning a reason and the entry fee will be refunded **at the conclusion of the Show.**

CLOSING DATES FOR ENTRIES:

Entries close with the last mail Friday 10th March 2023. Entries received post marked after this date will be treated as late entries. The late entry fee will be an additional fee of \$50.00.

*****Please Note: These dates and fees will be strictly enforced*****

WITHDRAWALS:

Any person wishing to withdraw an entry should do so in writing and if received prior to 2nd April 2023, the entry fee will be refunded **at the conclusion of the Show** less 10% of the entry fee for administration costs.

Any cancellation after this date and prior to the Show will incur a penalty of 100% of the entry fee. (Dependant on the circumstances.)

SHOW ENTRY:

You will receive your acceptance via email in the form of a "**FINAL ADVICE SHEET**" prior to the show. Your entry number will be shown along with a floor plan. Your entrant number **MUST** be quoted to receive your passes.

TROPHIES AND PRIZE MONEY:

STREET CLASS: Top Hot Rod, Street Machine, etc. receive an award plus \$300.00 each.

Class 1st Place receive an award plus (\$50.00 gift card sponsored by ASMF.)

Class 2nd & onward receive an award.(dependant on quantity entered)

Best Paint, Interior, Engine Bay & Undercarriage Awards where applicable.

****NEW IN 2023****

ELITE SHOW CLASS: THE MILTY AWARD:

Winner receives a \$3000.00 prize generously sponsored by Pat's Pro Resto's & Refinishing.

NOTE! Vehicle does not need to be road registered to qualify for this Award.

Best Paint, Interior, Engine Bay & Undercarriage Awards.

TOP TEN OF SHOW OVERALL:

Winners receive an award plus \$300.00 each.

CLUB STAND AWARDS:

Club stand awards will be presented as follows: -

1st \$ 600.00 Award plus Trophy.

2nd \$ 350.00 Award.

3rd \$ 200.00 Award

Note: To be eligible for this award the club stands must meet the minimum requirements as set by the Promoter.

PLEASE NOTE: Club Stands require a minimum of three (3) vehicles to be eligible. There will be a limit of four (4) vehicles per stand. Clubs wishing to display more than four (4) vehicles may be accepted at the discretion of the show committee.

SUBSTITUTE VEHICLES ON CLUB STANDS ONLY:

Cars on club stands **may** be substituted by other club cars up to 10th March 2023. After 10th March any substitute will be required to pay the late entry fee of \$50.00. Substitute vehicles for club stands will only be accepted providing the number of entries on the relevant club stand have been entered and paid for by the closing date of 10th March 2023. The Show Manager must be notified in writing of substitute vehicles and be accompanied by an official entry form, relevant fee and a current photograph.

INDIVIDUAL DISPLAY:

Awards will be presented as follows:

- 1st \$300.00 Award plus Trophy.
- 2nd \$250.00 Award
- 3rd \$150.00 Award

Note: To be eligible for the individual display awards stands must meet the minimum requirements as set by the promoter

BEST DISPLAYED VEHICLE:

- 1st \$300.00 Award plus Trophy.

CARS FOR SALE:

QHRP will provide the only 'FOR SALE' signs to be used in the Show. The owner will be required to fill in a 'fact sheet' that our Show Office will be able to photocopy and supply to prospective buyers. This service will incur a fee of \$27.50 Incl GST. **WE reserve the right to reject any car.**

STAND PRESENTATION:

The 2023 Queensland Hot Rod Show is the QLD State Titles and therefore entrants are required to display their vehicle in a professional manner. While the mode of exhibition is left entirely to individual choice, artistic and attractive displays designed to enhance the vehicle are highly recommended.

All plant, machinery and exhibits must comply with statutory requirements of Safety.

Minimum requirements are:

- a) Some form of floor covering. The use of polystyrene bubbles is strictly forbidden and excessive use of black garden plastic should be avoided.
- b) A strong crowd barrier.
- c) A sign giving details of the vehicle.
- d) Accent and display lighting is recommended but optional.

NOTE: Any display using *SAND, GRAVEL, DIRT OR BARK* etc., must have plastic sheeting underneath and a *BORDER*, a minimum of 100mm in height, around the display to hold back covering material.

Anyone using material which may cause dust is advised to be considerate of others during set-up. Individual and club stand presentation must meet the minimum requirements set by the promoter. This also includes full utilization of requested stand space by individuals or clubs, i.e. full number of originally entered vehicles. Any dispute regarding a club or individual stand not meeting the required standard or correct number of vehicles will be mediated by the QHRP Show Committee. Boundary fences or backdrops on all stand sites other than wall sites must not exceed one metre in height. Should the design of your stand necessitate the use of a higher boundary fence or backdrop written permission must be obtained from the QHRP Show Committee. Entrants shall not exchange stands or sub-let all or any portion of such stand without prior approval of the Show Manager.

CLASSIFICATION:

All classes are dependent upon sufficient numbers of entries and sections may be expanded or combined according to the entries received. To be eligible for Street Rod, Street Machine or Custom classes, a vehicle must be driven into the show facility; this is to be witnessed by a Steward or Show Official.

Competition Class is only for ANDRA and CAMS class vehicles issued with a current log book.

NOTE: Classification of vehicles are set and laid out in the ASRF and/or ASMF Rule Books –

THE CLASSIFICATIONS ARE SET BY THE ASRF and/or ASMF AND NOT THE PROMOTER.

STREET CLASSES REQUIRE PROOF OF CURRENT REGISTRATION.

INSURANCE:

Entrants shall not in any way do anything which would prejudice the Fire Insurance Risk on the buildings, and we recommend entrants provide at their expense fire extinguishers as considered necessary by the Fire Brigade Inspectors.

The Committee and/or Qld Hot Rod Association Ltd accepts no responsibility for the insurance or otherwise of exhibits against loss or damage, and shall not be liable for loss by fire, theft, riot, accident or other causes, and the entrant hereby undertakes to keep QHRA Ltd. indemnified against all claims whatsoever and howsoever arising out of erection, display or dismantling of exhibits, also without affecting the generality of the above in respect to:

- a) Any action which may be taken by the Brisbane Show Grounds or other authority with regard to the removal, alterations or rejection of any stand, structure or exhibit, and no liability shall attach to the Committee or QHRA Ltd in respect to any such action.
- b) Any claims made by the Brisbane Show Grounds or other authority to cover damage to its property by the entrant, his/her servants or agents or contractors.
- c) Any claim made by any person for injury or loss arising out of or connected with any exhibits or the display, use, erection or dismantling of the same.

The Committee and/or QHRA Ltd. will not under any circumstances be responsible for any loss to the entrant/exhibitor caused by breakdown or defect of lights, power or any other service or failure in respect of any of the arrangements or for any cause whatsoever.

Public Liability Insurance! It is highly recommended to have this cover. This can be arranged by QHRA Ltd. at a nominal **cost of \$20.00.** please include with your Entry fee and Judging fee. QHRA Ltd. shall not be liable or deemed to be liable for any loss, damage, theft or injury sustained by an entrant or any associates/employees of an entrant. Entrants shall be responsible for arranging Worker's Compensation Insurance in respect of all persons engaged by them.
